2015 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Misco

Vinous 92 pts

Bright straw. Musky aromas of ripe yellow fruit, pepper, dry herbs and balsamic oils. Then large, ripe and saline, offering fleshy orchard fruit and savory flavors that linger nicely. A rather tactile Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi that finishes long and lemony but with repeating herbal notes. The Misco is made from a single vineyard characterized by soils that are slightly richer in clay than the other estate vineyards; the vines are south-facing and roughly 20 years old. ("Misco" is the ancient name of the nearby Musoneiver.)

Gambero Rosso 3 bicchieri

2016 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Misco

Wine Enthusiast 89 pts

This wine's yellow flower, citrus and orange zest aromas waft from the glass. The juicy, enveloping palate offers chamomile, pineapple and lime flavors alongside bright acidity.

James Suckling 90 pts

Very fresh with plenty of apple and lemon aromas. This is fresh and lively, but it also has good substance and length. Drink or hold.

Gambero Rosso 3 bicchieri

2017 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Misco

Wine Spectator 90 pts

A lithe, light-bodied white, framed by bright, lemony acidity and a subtle, minerally underpinning, this shows well-knit flavors of Jonagold apple, peach skin, ground ginger and Thai basil. Drink now through 2022.

Gambero Rosso 3 bicchieri

2016 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Villa Torre

James Suckling 89 pts

A vibrant Verdicchio with a great combination of fresh nuts and lemon-peel character on the nose. Crisp and lively, but it is a little bit edgy at first. This nonetheless succeeds in terms of freshness. Drink now.

Vinous 91 pts – Ian d'Agata

Bright pale straw-green. Fresh floral aromas of nectarine, pear and yellow apple are complicated by potpourri. Then steely and juicy, with good inner-mouth perfume to the ripe apple and pear flavors. Finishes bright and savory. This spends four months on the lees and is aged in stainless steel only. The wines are on average 20 years old.

Wine Enthusiast 90 pts

Bartlett pear and Spanish broom aromas emerge from this wine. The savory palate delivers pink grapefruit, yellow peach and pineapple flavors set against crisp acidity. It closes on an almond note. Drink through 2023.

2017 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Superiore Villa Torre

Wine Spectator 88 pts

Light-bodied and juicy, this fresh white offers a crowd-pleasing range of Gala apple, honeysuckle, Marcona almond and lemon zest notes. Drink now through 2022.

2010 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Misco Riserva

Vinous 92+ pts – Ian d’Agata

Vivid green-tinged straw-yellow. Intense, mineral-dominated aromas of fresh citrus and orchard fruits, menthol, fennel and white flowers. Palate-staining, densely packed pear and Meyer lemon flavors are complicated by flint and chlorophyll nuances. Penetrating and pure on the finish, this rich, dense wine really improves with aeration, developing additional complexity and depth. I particularly like the way this Verdicchio delivers showy fruit within a strong mineral context.

2014 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Misco Riserva

James Suckling 87 pts

A slight reductive edge and then crisp melon, pears and lemons follow. A light body. Drink now.

2015 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Misco Riserva

Wine Enthusiast 90 pts

Delicate lemon and white spring flower aromas take shape in this wine. The savory, structured palate offers ripe tropical fruit, creamy yellow peach, ginger and toasted almond notes alongside bright acidity. Drink through 2022.

2016 Verdicchio dei Castelli di Jesi Classico Misco Riserva

Wine Spectator 90 pts

A sleek, light- to medium-bodied white, with drive to the flavors of nectarine and lemon thyme. Offers hints of pastry cream and pink grapefruit peel, with a smoky, mineral underpinning. Drink now through 2023.

2015 Rosso Piceno Cervidoni

James Suckling 90 pts

A rich and fruity red with dried berries and hints of dark chocolate and wet earth. Full body with round and juicy tannins. Drink now.

2017 Rosato

Vinous 91 pts – Ian d’Agata

Vivid orange-tinged pink. Cherry, redcurrant, musky peach and spices on the fragrant, aromatic nose. Deeply pitched, perfumed red berry and blood orange flavors show a noteworthy herbal edge, along with complicating notes of anise. Vibrant and well-balanced on the long crisp finish. A blend of Lacrima and Sangiovese.

2018 Rosato

Vinous 90 pts

Bright pink. Lively aromas of red berries and musky herbs. Fresh salty and savory in the mouth, with flavors of red cherry, blood orange and repeating musky herbs. Finishes long and delicately savory.

2016 Il Pestifero

Wine Enthusiast 89 pts

Fun and fizzy, this foaming blend of 75% Verdicchio, 15% Sangiovese and 15% Malvasia has delicate pressed wildflower, citrus and wild herb aromas that follow through to the palate. It's bright and crisp, with a dry, quenching finish.
