2016 Barbaresco Angelo

Vinous (92-95) pts – Antonio Galloni

The 2016 Barbaresco Angelo is beautifully delineated and lifted. The purity of the fruit is compelling, but it is the wine's total sense of harmony that elevates the Angelo in 2016. There is so much to look forward to.

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2016 Barbaresco Ronchi

Vinous (92-95) pts – Antonio Galloni

The 2016 Barbaresco Ronchi, one of the estate's flagships, is super- expressive today. Medium in body and gracious, with pretty red/purplish berry fruit, the 2016 is all sensuality and class. I can't wait to taste it from bottle.

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2016 Barbaresco Ovello Vigna Loreto

The 2016 Barbaresco Ovello Vigna Loreto is a tense and lithe, as wines from this site tend to be. Chalk, mint and red berry fruit are laced together in a nervy, energetic Barbaresco that looks to have a bright future.

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2016 Barbaresco Cottà

Vinous (91-94) pts – Antonio Galloni

Dark cherry/plum fruit and spice notes flesh out in the 2016 Barbaresco Cottà. Pliant and supple, with terrific depth and power, the Cottà is shaping up to be absolutely terrific.

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2016 Barbaresco Montersino

The 2016 Barbaresco Montersino is powerful and sculpted. In the glass, the 2016 is crystalline and expressive, although it is a bit more austere and less sensual than some of the other wines in the range.

Rocca's 2016 Barbaresco is a gorgeous wine. Pliant, deep and beautifully perfumed, the 2016 offers striking depth and class, with pretty floral and red berry fruit notes that carry through to the finish.
